Dear WUSD Community,

The WUSD School Community aware that we are working closely with our Tribal EOC and with IHS to prepare for Phase 2 of our “Return to Learn” plan. Right now, COVID19 counts are slowing in the Whiteriver community and the Tribe has moved to Phase 2 and has begun talk about moving to Phase 3, so WUSD would like to begin preparing to move to our Phase 2 later in October.

**Phase 2 of the WUSD “Return to Learn” plan will allow families of students K-6 to choose between two learning options.** Students may continue to learn from home via their Chromebooks and hotspots. Or students may return to some in-person learning on the school campuses. Pre K-3<sup>rd</sup> grade students will be on campus Monday through Thursday in smaller class sizes. 4th-6<sup>th</sup> grade students will be at the CDJH campus for in-person learning on an A-B schedule either Mondays and Wednesdays or Tuesdays and Thursdays. On Fridays, all PreK-6<sup>th</sup> grade students will either work from home or be invited on campus in small groups to have small group intervention learning.

We will also be sending printed forms with student meals. You can also call your child’s school and let them know which option you prefer: home learning or on campus learning. **The deadline for informing WUSD of your learning choice is Friday, October 2.** This will provide us with time to be well prepared for the start of Phase II. All students participating in on-campus learning will be required to have a waiver and confidentiality release on file.
