As we wrap up this school year, let's celebrate all that we have accomplished together. I am excited for what the future holds and look forward to continuing this journey with you next year.

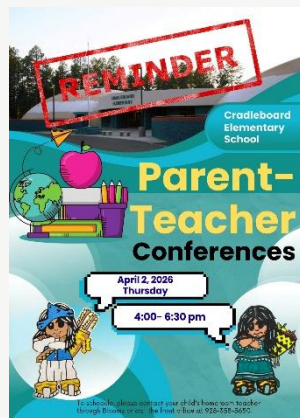

Kindergarten Round-Up and Future Scouts School Visit



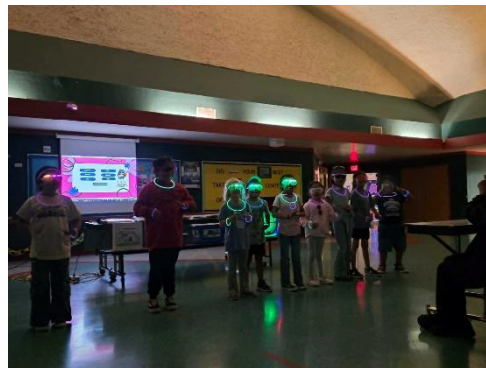
