# Fall Assessments Complete: Now What?

We've recently completed our beginning-of-year assessments, including DnA and Aimsweb testing for all students. We want to share how these assessments help us support your child's learning journey and how you can reinforce these skills at home.

Why These Assessments Matter:

The DnA and Aimsweb assessments are not traditional "tests" with pass/fail grades. Instead, they give our teachers valuable information about:

- Your child's current skills in reading and math
- Specific areas where your child excels
- Skills that may need additional support
- How to group students for targeted instruction

These assessments allow us to personalize learning for your child rather than using a one-size-fits-all approach. Teachers use this data to create small groups, select appropriate materials, and determine which concepts need more focus in the classroom.

#### **Supporting Learning at Home**

You can reinforce what we're doing at school with these simple activities:

For Reading:

- Read with your child for 15-20 minutes daily
- Ask questions about stories: "What do you think will happen next?" or "Why did the character make that choice?"
- Play word games during car rides or while waiting in line
- Point out words on signs, menus, and packages during everyday activities (continue to next page)

## Fall Assessments Complete...

For Math:

- Practice counting objects during daily routines (cereal pieces, stairs, cars)
- Look for patterns in your home or neighborhood
- Measure ingredients while cooking together
- Play board games that involve counting, strategy, or money.


### **August Updates**
