I have read and understand the following:

- 1. My student is an enrolled in the WUSD and I have completed the registration packet for this year.
2. My student must physically reside within district boundaries to participate in the online school option.
3. Students will be required to complete online assignments daily. Parents/guardians must be responsible for monitoring student progress and assisting students to complete assignments every day.
4. If an online student is dropped from enrollment due to "non-attendance", they will need to enroll for in-person school.
5. WUSD cannot guarantee that hotspots will provide internet access to every home location. Families are responsible for ensuring their students locate wi-fi to successfully complete online curriculum.
6. Online students must meet the same attendance/promotion/graduation requirements as in-person students.
7. Technology support will be slower than last year due to limited staff resources.
8. Families that owe a fee for previous lost or damaged chromebooks/hotspots must make a payment prior to receiving a new chromebook/hotspot. Families that lost or damaged two chromebooks during the 2020-2021 school year will not be eligible for another WUSD chromebook unless fees are paid in full.
9. Chromebooks, hotspots, and power cords that are lost or nonfunctioning due to misuse will not be replaced.
10. The WUSD online school option will be available for the first semester of the 2021-2022 school year. The district will re-evaluate the need for an on-line program before the start of the second semester.
11. Students must attend in-person school in order to participate in sports programs.
12. Most related Exceptional Student Services will be provided on-campus.
13. Students that are already enrolled and attending in-person school and wish to switch to the online school option must have an application submitted no later than end of day on Wednesday, September 1st. There are limited seats available for the WUSD Online School option. Students will be accepted on a "first come" basis.
