

Volunteer Packet

Thank you for your interest in volunteering your time for the benefit of our schools and students. Whiteriver Unified School District (WUSD) is an Arizona State publicly funded school. Therefore, per Arizona Revised Statute, there are a few requirements you will need to complete before volunteering with our students. To complete the process will need to do the following:

- 1. Complete a WUSD Volunteer application.
- 2. Provide a White Mountain Apache Tribal "Rap Sheet", which can be obtained from the tribal court.
- 3. Provide a copy of a valid Arizona fingerprint clearance card. *Check with Personnel office if you need assistance with the fingerprinting process.

Once all the items above have been completed your name will be presented to the WUSD Governing Board for approval. Upon approval you will be notified of the date you may begin to volunteer. These requirements are mandated from the State of Arizona (A.R.S. 15-512).

Volunteer Guidelines:

- 1. Volunteers who are not exempt WUSD employees, should not be left alone with students at any time.
- 2. Volunteers can only participate in activity/athletics for which they are governing board approved. *Additional approval is required for additional activities and/or athletic events/sports.
- 3. Volunteers may not ride in district vehicles without prior consent of the site administrator and/or athletic director (AD) and should not take the place of a student, when applicable. *A signed waiver must be completed prior to riding district transportation.
- 4. Volunteers may not drive district vehicles unless they are an exempt WUSD employee who is an approved volunteer and has consent from the site administrator and/or AD.
