# Power Quarter/State Assessments

3<sup>rd</sup> quarter is here! 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter is known as the Power Quarter – because we must power on and through. It is also known as the Power Quarter because state assessments are right around the corner.

State assessments are mandated and required by the State of Arizona and the federal Department of Education. It is IMPERATIVE that your student(s) be at school all day everyday. So much learning occurs during the day that students really can't afford to miss out on any part of the school day. Students taking the AZELLA (Arizona English Language Learner Assessment) will begin testing with Mrs. Taylor next week. We hope to have all students who take the AZELLA finished the first 2 weeks of February.

Students in  $3^{rd}$ ,  $4^{th}$ , and  $5^{th}$  grade will begin taking the state assessment shortly after spring break. All students will take a Reading, Math, and Writing test.  $5^{th}$  grade students will also take a Science test.

If your student is sick, please keep them home. Lots of illnesses are being shared right now. They must be fever-free for 24 hours WITHOUT the use of medication before they can come back to school. That being said, school is from 8:45a-3:45p. Early checkouts and late arrivals cut into student learning.
