State Testing is fast approaching-

The purpose of state testing is to determine whether your child has mastered the skills that he or she should know for a specific grade level. Think of the skills that your child is learning in school as building blocks. Each year, the skills build on each other.

Attendance is important- make sure that your child is here every day. There will be practice tests in class and review sessions to get them ready for the state tests. In 3rd grade, it may affect whether your child can move to the next grade level.

Make sure your child gets a good night's sleep on the night before the test. On the morning of the exam, give your child a good breakfast or send them to school on time to get breakfast. This will help keep your child's energy up and improve their ability to focus. Breakfast begins at 8:30 Reminder: School begins every day @ 8:45
