### ***State Testing is fast approaching-***

The purpose of state testing is to determine whether your child has mastered the skills that he or she should know for a specific grade level. Think of the skills that your child is learning in school as building blocks. Each year, the skills build on each other.

Attendance is important- make sure that your child is here every day. There will be practice tests in class and review sessions to get them ready for the state tests. In 3<sup>rd</sup> grade, it may affect whether your child can move to the next grade level.

Make sure your child gets a good night's sleep on the night before the test. On the morning of the exam, give your child a good breakfast or send them to school on time to get breakfast. This will help keep your child's energy up and improve their ability to focus. Breakfast begins at 8:30
