

Alchesay High School: Student Dress Code Policy

The student dress code policy teaches respectable standards that prevents disruption and exhibits safety. Parents and students are to comply with the following:

Headware & Accessories:

- Students wearing bandanas (any color), sunglasses, hoods are not permitted for safety purposes. Hoods should not be worn in the building including classrooms.



Shirts, Tops, Dresses

- All shirts, tops, blouses **MUST FULLY** cover the shoulders (NO sleeveless, no strapless, no racerback tops)
- No low-cut, plunging revealing necklines, backless tops, or see-through/sheer/lacy tops and crop tops/baby tees.
- Student's midsection abdomen (stomach area) **MUST** always be fully covered at all times.
- Clothing must **NOT** display or reference:
 - Tobacco, alcohol, drugs, illicit drugs
 - Obscene, vulgar, profane or similar language and images



Bottoms

- Skirts, dresses, shorts must **NOT** be sitting at the upper thigh area including any slits.
- Rips, tears, or holes in pants or jeans must be below fingertip length.
- Leggings must be worn underneath to prevent revealing visible skin.



NOT ALLOWED

- No bandanas of any color in any shape or form allowed, sunglasses or wearing hoods in the buildings and classrooms.
- No strapeless, spaghetti strap, low-cut, backless, sheer, see-through and off the shoulder clothing.
- Midsection stomach area **MUST** be covered at all times.
- No clothing that displays or references tobacco, alcohol, drugs, illegal substances, obscene, vulgar or profance language or images allowed.
- Students are **NOT** to be applying makeup or other grooming behaviors in class during instruction.

- Students out of school dress code per school policy will be handled with discipline consequence and correction as needed.
- Teachers and school staff are to report students violating the dress code immediately.
