## Components of the Physical System

- 1. The frame that the board sits on
  - Can accommodate 200 lbs. of force. The board itself weighs about 150 lbs.
- 2. The actual display (looks like a big monitor).



3. The thin client computer that runs the board.



#### Turning on the View Sonic Board

- 1. There is a power button on the bottom right hand part of the board.
- 2. Make sure the board is plugged in :D
- 3. There is a power button on the thin client that runs the board (right side behind the display).
- 4. There is an on-off toggle next to where the power plugs into the display on the bottom of the board.

## Logging in to the View Sonic Display Board



Turn the board on and log into it like you would any WUSD computer.

If you see this screen, it's OK. Just touch PC at the bottom and then log in



## You can use the ViewSonic Board like a big touch screen!

Access any files in your documents, display and present a Powerpoint, write or type in a Word document or show a video on YouTube. If your curriculum resources include online tools then you can use those the same way you would from your desktop.

Sometimes you will need to sync your documents with your district online profile by restarting your laptop on campus.

# Use the board in the same way you would a projector


You can plug in any USB C or HDMI cable to the board. Plug cables in to the HDMI port under the computer on the right side. Then push the settings button on the front of the board. Select the HDMI port you plugged in to.



USE the Whiteboard Program....Double click on it on your desktop.







Use the Windows button to toggle back and forth to your desktop.






Use these tools to return to the whiteboard program, take a picture of whatever you are looking at on the screen or write on the screen and then save it to your whiteboard.


#### Use what you already have!
