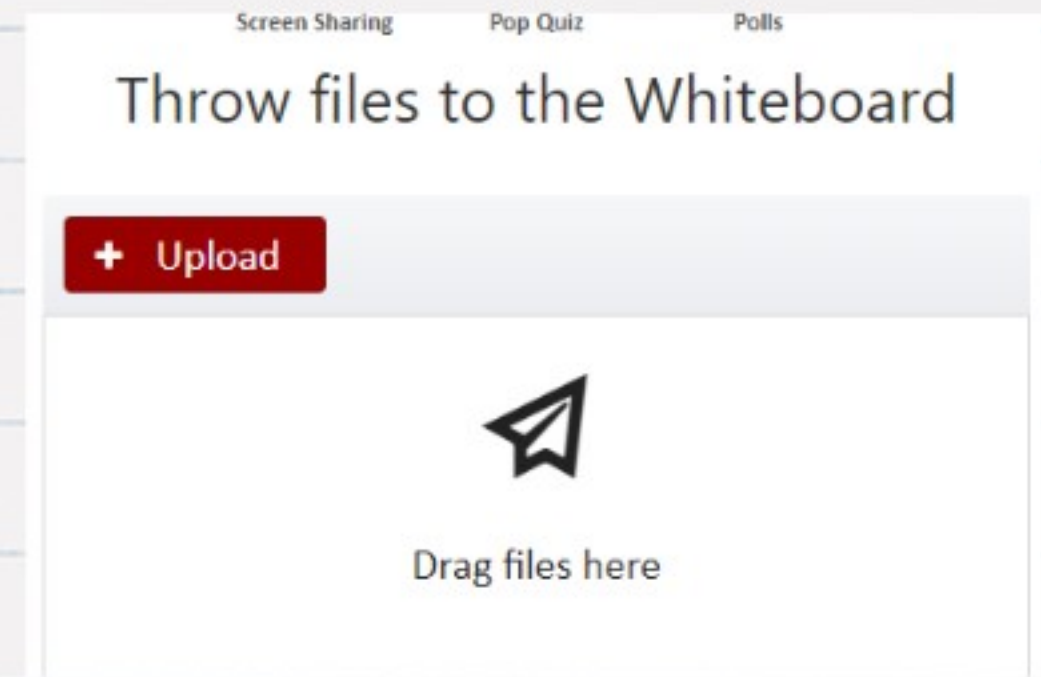

You can have students send a picture of work they have done to your board. They can take a picture using the camera app on a chromebook or they can show you anything on their screen. This is called Throwing to the board.






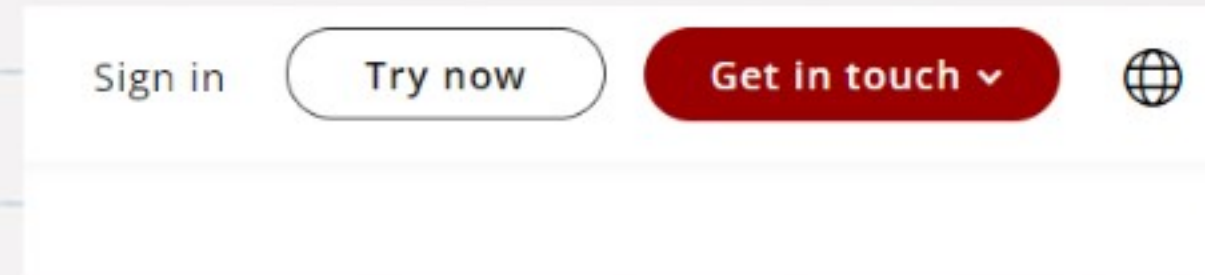
# Set up your board name and login

Click Sign in on the top right side of the screen.



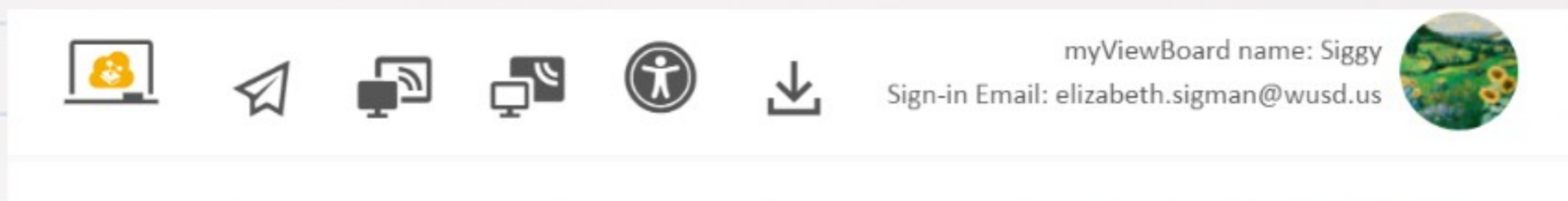

Click next to your email address at the top-right to change your account settings.

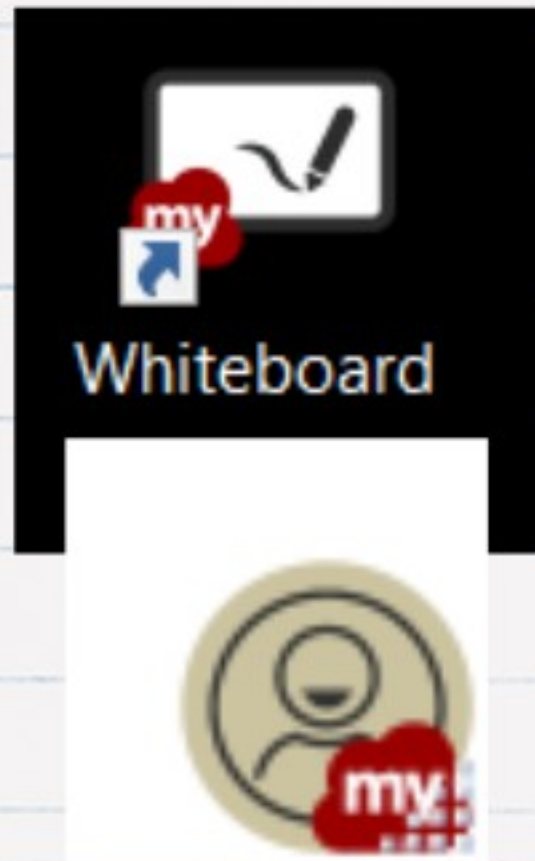

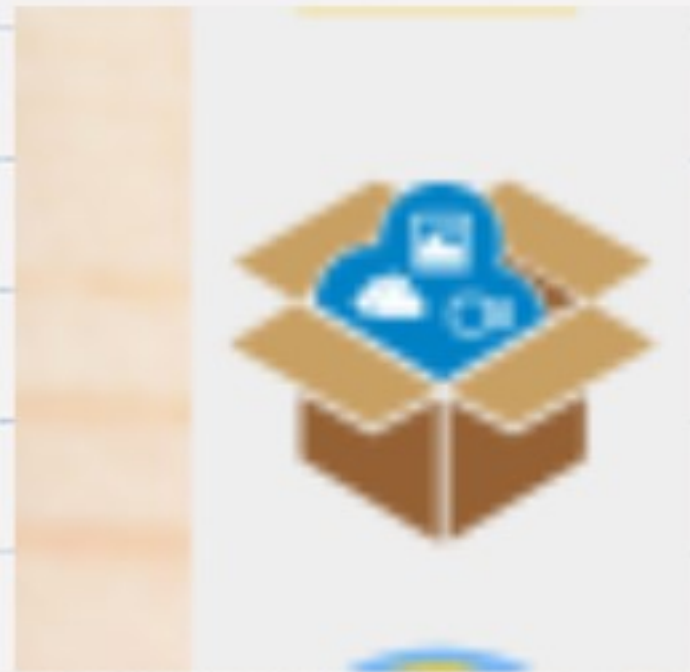

**2 a.**  $\frac{b + 5}{8} = 7$

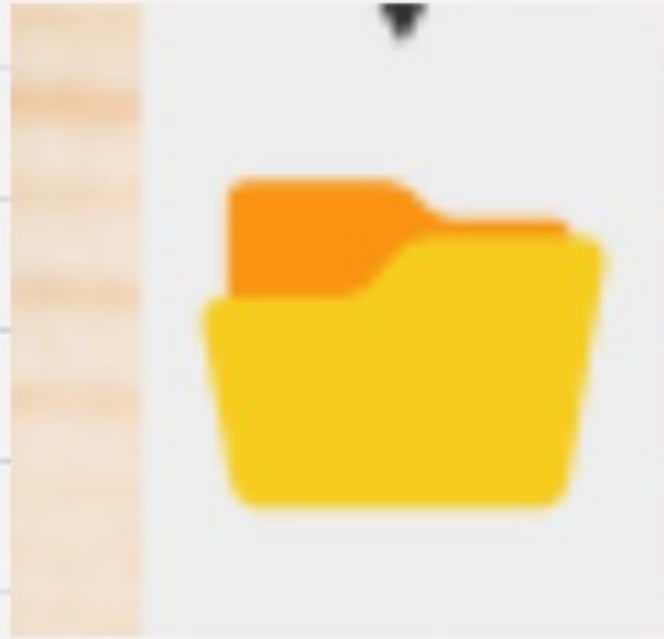
**2 b.**  $12 = 12 - 7t$

**3 a.**  $\frac{v + 12}{12} = 4$

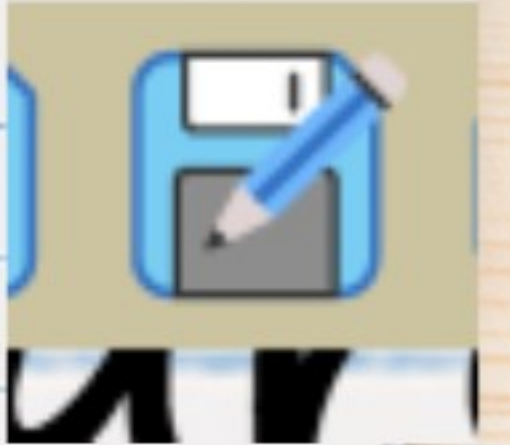
**3 b.**  $\frac{1 - v}{12} = 5$

- Save your work periodically using the Save button.



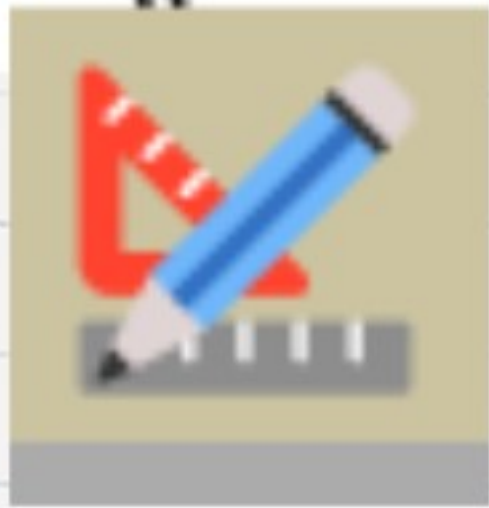
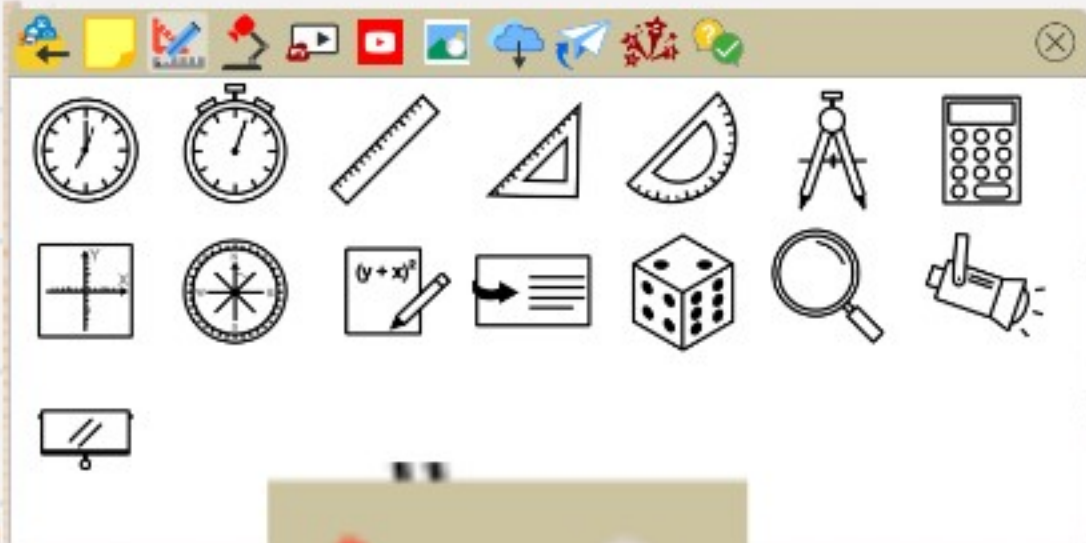
## The File Menu - Pro Tip

- If you teach multiple class periods of a single prep, save your lesson with the date and then export a PDF that contains what you added during the lesson for each class period as a PDF. You can then post this or send to kids as notes they missed or a review.





# Other tools

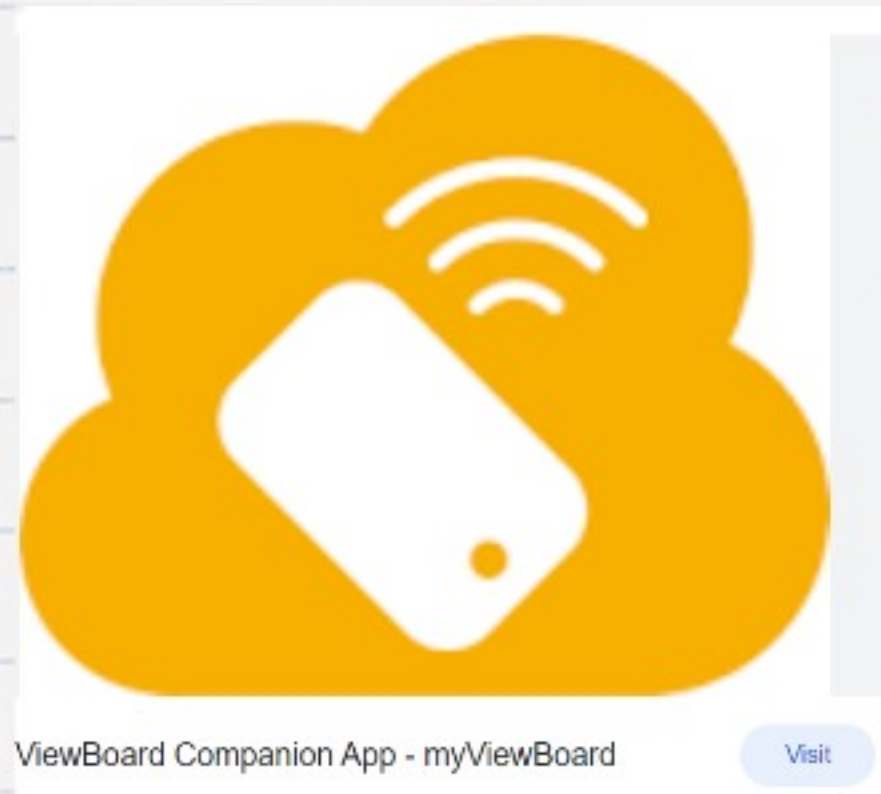


You find these using the magic box and the tools button (looks like a triangle and ruler) - Click and drag out tools you want to use

# The MyViewBoard Companion App

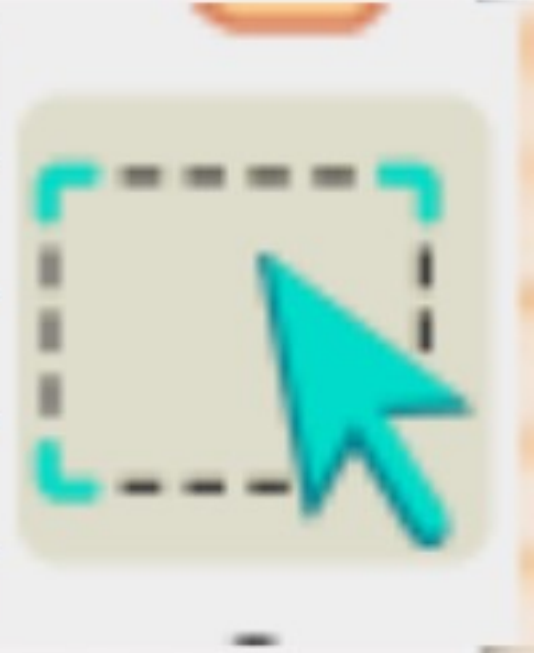


Available in Google Play or Apple App store. It is free. You can log in, throw images to any board, control your instance of whiteboard and use a laser pointer!



Any object or tool on the screen has options

Use the select tool and click on an object or picture to see the options for that thing and customize it.





# Tips and Tricks



- When you are designing a lesson...**SAVE CONSTANTLY!!!!!!**
- When you are signed in to one instance of the Whiteboard software and you open another one, even on another device, it closes the one you are currently in and you loose any unsaved work.
