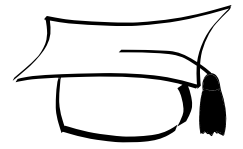




# 2025 Graduation

## **SENIOR GRADES ARE DUE – Monday MAY 19, 2025**

- Ask your teachers to check your final grades before May 19. Turn in late work or make-up work ASAP.

## **GRAD WALK AT THE ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS – Monday May 19, 2025**

- Graduates bring their cap & gown.
- Meet at the front office at 11:00 am → Walk to Whiteriver Elementary School.
- Graduates will load the bus at 12:00 p.m. and leave for SME, CBE, CDJH
- Participation is optional.

## **SENIOR CHECKOUT - LAST DAY OF SCHOOL FOR SENIORS – Tuesday MAY 20, 2025**

- This is your last day of school and is a regular school day for you. Students are not to be checked out of school.
- You must return any library books, textbooks, athletic uniforms or other school property you may have.
- You will receive a checkout form in your 1<sup>st</sup> period class and you will get teacher signatures during your regular class time. You are not allowed to miss class to complete the form. Students will not be allowed to go around during class hours to get signatures. Again, students must attend all 6-classes on time and no check-outs this day.
- You will not be allowed to practice in graduation practice if you do not complete the checkout form.

## **MANDATORY PRACTICE DATES**

**\*Sunglasses not allowed during practices and during ceremony\***

### **Wednesday May 21, 2025: 11:00a.m. – 3:00p.m.**

**\*Do not be late!**

- You must meet all graduation requirements by 9:00 a.m. on this day to participate in the ceremony.
- You must report to the Activity Center for mandatory practice.
- Bring the shoes to practice that you will be wearing for graduation. This will help determine whether or not you will wear a particular pair of shoes.
- Practice is mandatory - if you do not attend practice then you will not be allowed to participate in the ceremony.
- Decorating will occur after practice. Please stay to help with decorating as the more help we have the more we will be able to get done.

**Thursday May 22, 2025: 8:00a.m. - 11:00a.m.**

**\*Do not be late!**

- You will report directly to the Activity Center for practice.
- Bring the shoes to practice that you will be wearing for graduation. This will help determine whether or not you will wear a particular pair of shoes.
- Practice is mandatory - if you do not attend you will not be allowed to participate in the ceremony.
- Decorating will occur after practice. Stay to help with decorating as the more help we have the more we will be able to get done.

**Students who are showing any signs and symptoms of inappropriate substance use at practice and checking in for the ceremony you will not be allowed to participate in the ceremony. If you are suspended during the last week of school, you will not be allowed to participate in the ceremony.**

**GRADUATION CEREMONY AT ACTIVITY CENTER - MAY 22, 2025 at 6:00 P.M.**

- **Graduates report to the Activity Center and check in with Ms. Tancioco and Mrs. Bjarnson by 5:00 p.m.**  
The ceremony will begin immediately at 6:00 p.m., do not be late!!
- Graduates must line up upon arrival and remain in your assigned spot until the ceremony begins. No wandering.
- General audience seating will be on a first come, first serve basis.
- Graduates are required to wear a cap & gown or you may wear traditional attire, but the cap is still required.
- Caps are not to be decorated on top. Two exceptions are beaded edges and a feather may hang with the tassel.

- Parking at the Activity Center and overflow parking will be at the AHS school parking lot.
- Parking for elders and handicap will be in the marked handicapped parking spaces at the Activity Center.
- AC Doors will be open to the public at 5:30 pm.
- The senior graduating students from Indian Club will perform 2 – 4 songs during the diploma distribution.
- Noisemakers (air horns, cow bells, whistles) and signs (including posters and banners), are not allowed in the graduation venue and their use is strictly prohibited. The throwing and/or the possession of beach balls, balloons, confetti or other related items at the graduation ceremony are strictly prohibited.
- At the conclusion of the graduation ceremony, in an effort to ensure the safety of all attendees, the audience will remain seated until all the graduates have exited their seating area.
- Guests will exit through the main entrance. AHS staff will exit through the back doors.
- Remember this is a ceremony to honor AHS graduates for their hard work and achievement. Graduates must be on their best behavior and are expected to behave appropriately at all times!
